## Instructions for Fret Cards

- Print out the separate fret cards \& individual note cards
- Cut out the fret cards and glue together (back to back) so that you will have 13 individual cards to memorize
- Fold the individual note card sheets in half. You could then laminate them and trim the to size
- You will then have all the individual notes on the guitar neck from open strings to the 12th fret. The name of the fret and string are on one side, the note name on the other.
- Time yourself just for the fun of the challenge.
